The Truth Project is designed to take participants on a guided worldview tour to direct our thinking with regard to four fundamental issues: Truth, God, Man, and the Social Order. Along the way, we will attempt to build a logical, systematic framework of ideas by which to organize and evaluate the various truth claims to be encountered during the course of our tour. Our ultimate goal is not simply to gain knowledge, but to look upon the face of God - and to be transformed in the process. Only



9% of professing Christians have a biblical worldview. Because of this, today's believers live very similarly to non-believers. The Truth Project is designed to transform our lives as we learn the answer to the question "What is Truth?"

This home study is the starting point for looking at life from a biblical perspective. Each lesson discusses in great detail the relevance and importance of living the Christian worldview in daily life. Everyone is welcome: Singles, Married, The Senior Set & Older Teens. We invite everyone to consider joining our group. If you have teens in the 11th and 12th grades this is a great opportunity to spiritually prepare them before they head off to college. The class has no homework and runs for 13 weeks on Thursday evenings from 7-9 beginning September 8th.


